





Local Government Receive \$3 Million to Expedite Building Permits

As a result of passage of legislation in Olympia the Washington State Department of Commerce (DOC) has awarded \$3 million to 16 cities to streamline and boost the building permit process for more housing.

The funds will create a digital permitting process and consolidate permit reviews for new housing production. This system will reduce delays and help cities and property owners expedite and new existing rehab construction.

Local Governments commit to issuing final decisions on residential permit applications within 45 business days or 90 calendar days. Seven communities received permit review grants.

We believe this infusion of \$3 million will help boost the supply of housing in these communities. We hope the legislature will contribute to additional funding in the 2025 session.

The purpose of the permitting project applies to residential, plus "rehabs," commercial and manufactured Housing Communities.
